#### Village of Park Forest Municipal Code of Ordinances (Peddler)

#### ARTICLE II.

#### LICENSE\*

\* State Law References: Authority of village to license and regulate, 65 ILCS 5/11-42-2.

#### Sec. 74-26. Required.

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the business of an itinerant merchant, peddler, or hawker in the village without first having obtained a license therefore. The fee for each itinerant merchant, peddler or hawker not using any truck or any vehicle shall be the same as that for a peddler using a vehicle. (Code 1966, § 23-1)

#### Sec. 74-27. Prerequisites to issuance.

No license shall be issued pursuant to this chapter unless the applicant therefore shall produce evidence, satisfactory to the village clerk, that the applicant is complying with state law relating to the tax imposed upon persons engaged in the business of selling tangible, personal property at retail. (Code 1966, § 23-2)

#### Sec. 74-28. Duration.

The annual period for the license required under this article shall be from January 1 to December 31. Semiannual, quarterly, and monthly licenses shall automatically expire not later than December 31 of the year in which issued.

(Code 1966, § 23-3)

#### Sec. 74-29. Vehicle tags.

Each licensee under this article, upon the payment of the annual, semiannual or quarterly license fee, shall be issued a metal tag for each vehicle or cart in operation in the village, and such tag shall be carried at all times in the vehicle and displayed when in the village, and shall be produced upon request by any village inspector or official. (Code 1966, § 23-4)

### Sec. 74-30. Acts, conduct of licensee.

No licensee under this chapter or agent, employee, or representative of such licensee shall:

- (1) Cheat or defraud any person in the village.
- (2) Make any false representations to any person in the village.
- (3) Barter, sell, or peddle any goods, wares, or merchandise other than those specified in his application for a license.
- (4) Make or cause to be made, permit or allow, while upon the streets, sidewalks and public places, any excessive noise of any kind by crying, calling, or shouting, or by means of any whistle, rattle, bell, horn, or similar device, for the purpose of advertising or of attracting the attention or inviting the patronage of any person. (Code 1966, § 23-5)
